As of Monday, January 26, 2009 at 07:00 hours, the Mercy Ambulatory Care Center (M.A.C.C.) will begin accepting patients by ambulance. This change became possible as they have been designated as a two (2) bed hospital.

We have been informed by our colleagues from New York State, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services that the disposition code will be **659**. The Medical Emergency Radio System and the ambulances will also utilize this designation for the M.A.C.C.
